The International Conference is organized within the frame of the Erasmus+ Project KA2 (2018-2020) *Families and Schools. The Involvement of Foreign Families in Schools* which aims at analyzing, designing and evaluating the involvement of immigrant-origin families in a network of 24 schools. The project implements a strategic partnership including 3 universities, 3 inspectorates, 3 primary schools in Spain (Catalonia), Italy (Lombardy), and Luxembourg.

Disadvantaged families - and immigrant parents among them - perform a poor interaction with teachers and the whole school institution due to many social, cultural, linguistic and organizational barriers. The lack of parental involvement and of 'educational alliances' between teachers and parents produces negative effects on student learning. On the contrary, as the sociological research highlights, there is a positive association between parental involvement and students' achievement. Participating in school life also leads foreign parents to be better integrated at a local level. How do the schools welcome immigrant-origin parents and encourage them to participate actively? What kind of strategies they enact to sort out from social distance, tensions, and relational difficulties with disadvantaged families? And which measures do they implement to increase the parental involvement among migrants?

The International Conference aims at: 1) debating about social challenges and the empowerment of migrant families; 2) presenting results from the first phase of the Erasmus+ project (the book *Families and Schools*); 3) sharing ideas and experiences on educational practices and success stories in foreign families' school involvement.
